2003: Cross-Border Local Grouping (Karlsruhe Treaty from 1996) Regio PAMINA 2017: European Grouping for Territorial Cooperation (European EGTC Regulation, 2nd edition from 2013)

1988: Declaration of Wissembourg (-> INFOBEST PAMINA, ARGE PAMINA)



# **Beeing an EGTC**


## **Effects**
